Flown in 2017, the Canada 150 Global Odyssey (C150GO) was the First Canadian Circumnavigation in Helicopter, an FAI Exceptional Air Sports Performance, and set the Guinness World Record™ for First Father and Son to Circumnavigate the World by Aircraft.

To celebrate the 150th anniversary of Canadian Confederation, the all-Canadian crew flew a Canadian-made Bell 429 helicopter eastwards around the globe, visiting every Canadian province and territory – as well as landmarks across the world spotlighting notable achievements and events from Canada's amazing history.

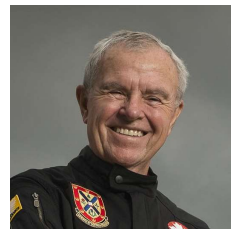
